The Administrator attended the meeting of the Admission Board of KMDC that comprised of Dr. Waqar Kazmi, Principal of KMDC, Professor Naila Zaheer, Dr. Zubair Abbasi, Professor Freeda Islam, Mr. Rafi Murshid Khan, Director Finance, Ms Nargis Shagufta, Director, Administration, Waseem Ahmed and other members of college staff. The college was full of applicants and their parents.

Briefing the Administrator, the Principal of KMDC mentioned that admission is granted every year for 350 seats in the college out of which 250 will be for MBBS and 100 for BDS. He said that 245 admissions will be given on open merit whereas 105 will be seats reserved for self finance and overseas Pakistanis that too are given on merit. He said that the admission board interviews more than 200 candidates a day and selects 600 for final selection to MBBS and BDS seats.
