Karachi, March 21: Administrator Karachi, Sindh governments Spokesman and CM Advisor on Law Barrister Murtaza Wahab on Monday said that one of the largest waterfalls in Pakistan named after Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto at Kidney Hill Park will be completed within two months.

"Lights towers have also been installed for lighting in the park. Soon Kidney Hill Park will be the best place for the citizens of Karachi," the Administrator said thia while speaking after laying the foundation stone of Benazir Bhutto Waterfall and inaugurating the Fauzia Wahab Garden at Kidney Hill Park here.

Director General Parks Junaidullah Khan, Senior Director Anti-Encroachment Bashir Siddiqui, local PPP leaders and others were also present on the occasion.

The Administrator Karachi said that special design of Benazir Bhutto Waterfall has been prepared in Kidney Hill Park. The waterfall will be 200 feet long and 25 feet high.

He said that Fauzia Wahab was an important leader of PPP who has done a great service to the city. More than 200 fruit trees have been planted in the Fauzia Wahab Garden in Kidney Hill Park named after Fauzia Wahab. "I will personally pay for Fauzia Wahab Garden," he added.

He said that four modern light towers have been installed for lighting in different parts of the park, adding that 24 lights have been installed in one tower and a total of 96 lights have been installed here.

Barrister Murtaza Wahab said that more such light towers will be installed here so that visitors to the park can move around easily even at night.

He said that Kidney Hill Park is being made the most lush region of Karachi. The park also has paved corridors and walking trails.

He said that these tracks are named after various mountains, rivers, lakes, trees, fruits, forests, national parks and deserts of Pakistan. He said that there is also a beautiful pond.

"KMC's Parks Department deserves congratulations for completing all these tasks in the best possible way and in the shortest possible time," he added.

The Administrator Karachi said that in fact it is a high-altitude airspace where from a height of 219 feet the city can be seen from afar.

"The beauty and greenery of these trees gives a pleasant feeling to the visitors. Kidney Hill Park will be an excellent oxygen tank for Karachi due to the abundance of trees and citizens away from environmental pollution can come here and enjoy the fun," said the Administrator.

He added that a water tank has also been constructed in the park to ensure water supply where plants and trees are irrigated by treating the sewage water.

He said that the present government was improving the parks and recreational areas of Karachi and the work started for the betterment of the city would continue in future also.
