Karachi, March 15: Administrator Karachi, Sindh government's Spokesman and CM Advisor on Law Barrister Murtaza Wahab on Tuesday said that the federal ministers trained in PTI are heading towards riots.

"Opposition parties have decided to use the option of no-confidence motion legally. I have always called PTI as Tehreek-e-Intishar. They used to create anarchy even while they were in opposition. The number of scandals in Imran Khan's government is unprecedented, the Administrator

expressed these views while addressing a press conference in the committee room of Sindh Assembly here.

Barrister Murtaza Wahab further said that the opposition parties have decided to bring the no-confidence motion legally and now it has come to the notice of the people that PTI is a party creating chaos.

"For the last three and a half years, this incompetent federal government has not given any good news to the people and every blame is always laid on the opposition," he added.

He said that the promises that Imran Khan and some of his partymen had made with the people in the days of opposition did not fulfil.

"Jobs were not given but people became unemployed. People did not get houses but they became homeless. Imran Khan had said that he would not be blackmailed. Those who did not go to the MQM office to seek votes went there as well. The Prime Minister came to Karachi but never solved the problem," the Administrator said.

Barrister Murtaza Wahab said that Imran Khan used to say that he would commit suicide and not go to the IMF but he went there too.

He said that there is no precedent for all the scandals that have come in Imran Khan's government. The scandals are for sugar, wheat, medicine.

Bllions of rupees were misappropriated in the sugar scandal but no action was taken. Action was not taken against anyone in the wheat scandal too.

He said that prices of medicines were increased and the concerned minister was removed. It was told that there would be an inquiry but the minister was given a senior post in the party.

"Given this situation, Imran Khan should go home himself. Due to these circumstances and incompetence, the opposition parties got an opportunity to exercise their constitutional right," he said that when people were seeing darkness, Bilawal Bhutto Zardari announced a historic public march.

He said that the people marched for 10 days and did not hold any sit-in. After the speech, people went home.

Barrister Murtaza Wahab said that the man who calls himself a leader of youth at the age of 70 is making fun of Bilawal Bhutto Zardari.

He said that if Speaker National Assembly takes any unconstitutional step, Article 6 will apply to him ans others.

The Administrator said that MQM is a political party and they are engaging it. "The response from MQM is positive. It (MQM) wants the Supreme Court decision to be implemented and so do we. When the PPP came to power in 2008, the 18th Amendment was passed and a lot of work was done," he added.
